1. Who We Are

The Forum of Firms (“FoF”, “we”, “us”) is an independent association of international networks of firms that have transnational audit appointments or are interested in accepting such appointments. The FoF works closely with the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC).

For the purposes of data protection law, the Forum of Firms is the data controller in respect of personal data collected through this website. IFAC acts as a data processor on behalf of the FoF for website administration and support.

2. What Does This Policy Cover?

This Privacy Policy applies only to personal data collected through the Forum of Firms website.

Information You Provide

Automatically Collected Information

The website may collect limited, anonymized technical information (such as aggregated website usage data) to help us understand how the site is used and to maintain its security and functionality. This information does not identify you directly.

4. How We Use Your Personal Data

We do not use website contact information for marketing purposes.

5. Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal data collected through the website on the basis of:

6. Who We Share Personal Data With

Personal data submitted through the website is shared only with:

- Relevant IFAC staff responsible for Forum of Firms activities; and
- Service providers that support website hosting, maintenance, or security, where appropriate safeguards are in place



We do not sell personal data or share it for commercial purposes.

7. How Long We Keep Personal Data

We retain personal data collected through the website only for as long as necessary to respond to your enquiry and for any follow-up that may be required, after which it is securely deleted or anonymized.
